

## **George Brown College Chef School Student Standards and Expectations**

## **Standards in Lab Class**

- Dress code is clean and pressed GBC Chef School uniform, trousers, chef jacket, apron, and 4-6 side towels
- Clean name tag
- Clean steel toed black nonslip safety shoes
- Clean GBC Chef School hat
- Hair tied back and held in place with hair net/beard net if needed (Chef School does not provide these)
- Clean knife roll and sharp knives
- Clean utensil container and utensils
- Clean bag and tubs for take home items
- Workplan double-sided (landscape print)
- No coats, boots, skateboards, or other outerwear to be brought into the lab. Students <u>must</u> have a locker for their personal belongings. Leave valuables at home
- NO visible piercings are permitted
- NO fake eyelashes are permitted
- NO nail polish is permitted
- NO air pods or headphones in labs
- NO gum chewing in the labs
- NO coffee cups or pop cans in the lab reusable water bottle use is encouraged filling stations available on every floor
- NO dirty uniforms in lab. If it was left in a bag overnight, it shouldn't be worn again.
- NO students are admitted late for demo or lab class
- Students must not arrive to the Chef School in uniform. Changing in hallways is not permitted. Students
  must use changerooms

## **Professionalism in Lab Class**

- Tardiness is unacceptable. Students are to be in lab class at least 30 minutes before class starts
  - 80% attendance is required to pass for practical labs
  - Students are required to let professor know of absences before class
- Smoking Not in front of the school doors or within 15 feet of any public entrance
- Cell phones switched off in classes
