George Brown was ranked as the

#1 research college in the country

for 2015, climbing from the #3 spot in 2014.¹

1,782 student researchers conducted 181 applied research projects

during the 2015/16 academic year, giving them hands-on experience solving real-world business problems.²

To date, George Brown has received more than \$57 million

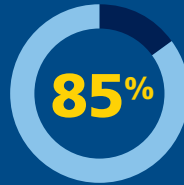
in research funding from provincial and federal programs, which has been matched by industry investments.³

\$8 million gift

from Toronto business leader **Jack Cockwell and the Brookfield Partners Foundation**—the largest one-time private donation in the history of Ontario's college system.



George Brown leads the GTA colleges in graduate employment rates at 85%.⁴



In 2015/16, 94% of our qualifying programs offered field education and we plan to boost that to 100% by 2020.

George Brown College's top 5 source countries for international enrolment for the 2015/16 year are:⁵



426 students completed international placements—286 work and 140 study—across 41 programs in 34 countries during 2015/16.⁶

Our Foundation awarded **1,140 scholarships** to students in 2015/16 with a value of more than **\$1.1 million.**⁷
