

## Liberal Studies Electives Offered Through Continuing Education *SPRING/SUMMER 2024*


The Continuing Education courses listed below are accepted as credit towards the *Liberal Studies Elective* requirements for degree programs. Other courses in the Continuing Education catalogue do **NOT** qualify for Liberal Studies elective credit.

Make sure you select courses that meet your program's breadth requirement (meaning that you have to take courses from at least two of the three categories – LHUM, LSCI, LSSC) and do not register for courses that are similar to courses that you have taken or will take in your program. It is best to check with the Electives Office ([LASelectives@georgebrown.ca](mailto:LASelectives@georgebrown.ca)) before you register if you are not sure whether a course meets the Liberal Studies elective requirements for your program.

Please note that the fees for Continuing Education classes are **NOT** included in your regular full-time tuition fees. You may pay and register for these courses through the Continuing Education website.
