





Outcomes-based learning

- Backwards Design: being able to imagine your course at the end – what do you want learners to take away? What's the "thing" that you want them to be able to do?
- Distinction between objectives and outcomes
 what is the difference?
- Importance of aligning outcomes with assessments ('authentic')
- Question: How should we re-imagine our outcomes and assessments in the age of AI?

The Universal Design for Learning Framework

Engagement "Why"

How students learn varies greatly: Access

Students are motivated to learn: Sustaining Effort & Persistance

Provide options & choices: Self-regulation

Goal: Learning will be purposeful & Motivated

Representation "What"

How to present learning material to maximize learning: Perception

Provide options i.e., videos, audio, graphics, gives options to learn in various ways: Language & Symbols

Make all materials accessible: Comprehension

Goal: Resourceful & Knowledgable

Action & | Expression "How"

Opportunity for students to demonstrate what they've learned: Physical Action

Provide choice
of assessment, while
maintaining robust
learning outcomes:
Expression &
Communication

Removes barriers interfering with student learning and promotes autonomy: Executive Functions

Goal: Strategic & Goal directed

Recommendations Based on Survey Results

- Required to take UDL Certificate:
 - o leadership, seasoned faculty, and faculty without UDL certificate.
- How to integrate 'accessibility' and 'AI' resources for content delivery i.e., power point, YouTube, Brightspace etc., during orientation week.
- Hybrid model.
- Materials were skewed to faculty over other groups in attendance.
- Supporting international students.
- Mental health first-aid, and beyond.
