Reported Speech



We use reported speech when we wish to report what someone else has said <u>without using a direct quote</u>. This can be useful when reporting on research or telling a story.

When we report what someone else has said we are **shifting our perspective of that speech**. Therefore, our language must reflect that shift in perspective.

There are 3 possible shifts that can occur in a quote that is being reported.

- **1.** A change of pronouns
- 2. A change in tense
- 3. Changes to time phrases
